Program: David Shulman



Owner of the Westside Animal Hospital in Santa Cruz, David was asked by Dr. Daniel Costa of UCSC's Long Marine lab to help radio tag Crabeater Seals on the Antarctic Peninsula as part of a global study using top predators to study the environment.

David's presentation took us all on a trip to the Antarctic, which requires several flight connections, eventually ending at a harbor at the very tip of South America. David spoke about the dangerous travel conditions around Cape Horn, and the type of Ship, specially designed to handle 30 ft. waves of below freezing water.

The conditions under which David's team searched for, found, tranquilized and then tagged these seals were incredible. The

presentation showed the Antarctic to be beautiful and dangerous, but alive with various mammals whose adaptations make their existence possible.
