Taking note of the current financial situation, Wally took time to review with fellow Rotarians, a few new financial anachronisms, such as:

Program: Matt McCaslin Fireman
There have been three major fires in Santa Cruz County during the last year. Matt reviewed the major fires in Santa Cruz beginning with the Pine Mountain fire in 1948. Pine Mountain is the largest fire in recent history, having consumed over 19,000 acres. The Ben Lomond (dump) Fire in 1954 spread to 1400 acres. In more recent history the Lexington Fire in 1985 consumed 14,000 acres.



The Summit Fire started in May of this last year burned 4200 acres and destroyed 63 homes. Then about two weeks later, the Martin Fire, which burned over 1000 acres, had 21 fire crews and over 800 fire fighting personnel on site. Matt reviewed the

logistics of fighting the fire, feeding and caring for the firefighters. He pointed out that in the last year, each one of us probably knew of a person who suffered hardship as a result of these local fires.
