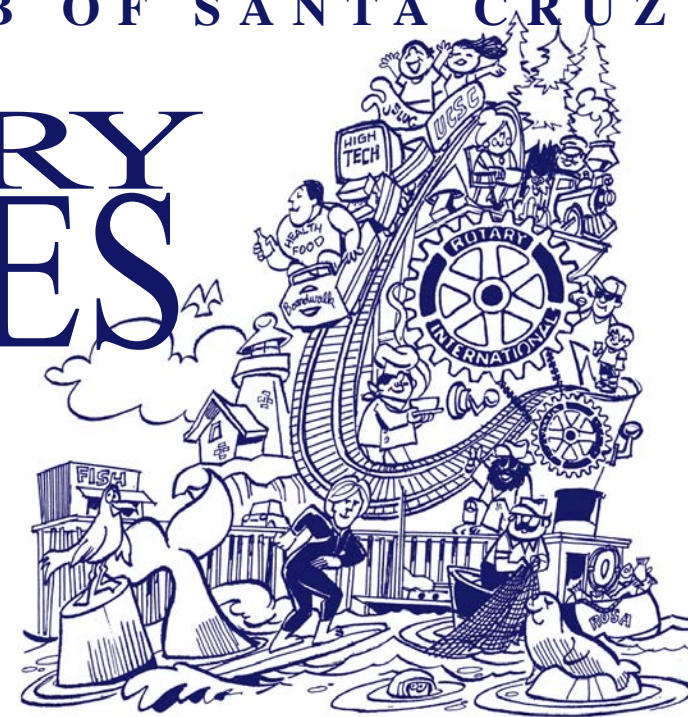

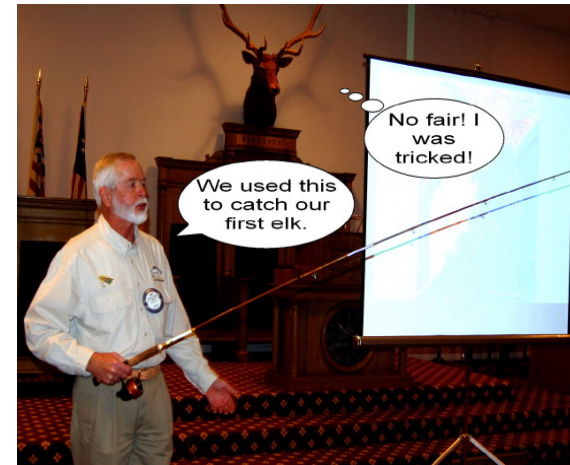
Raffle: Tom Canfield donated a bottle of wine and a gift certificate to Restaurante Italiano. Tom Honig had the winning numbers.

Program: Sam Bishop
Title: Fly Fishing in Kamchatka

First discovered by Russian Cossacks over three hundred thousand years ago, (and largely left alone after that) Kamchatka remains a largely undiscovered place with one road and over 3/4 of its population in one town. Sam Bishop traveled half way across the earth to fish in its wild streams and lakes.



Sam spent some time with those of us relatively unfamiliar with fishing for fly's. He covered the basics of casting, and how it is that lures appeal to fish, "fish can't see the top of the lure, so make the bottom pretty". (Levi Strauss said the same thing) could have told him that) Turns out their preferred food were small mice, who had the poor fortune to fall into the water. Sam is a great story teller and gave an interesting presentation.
