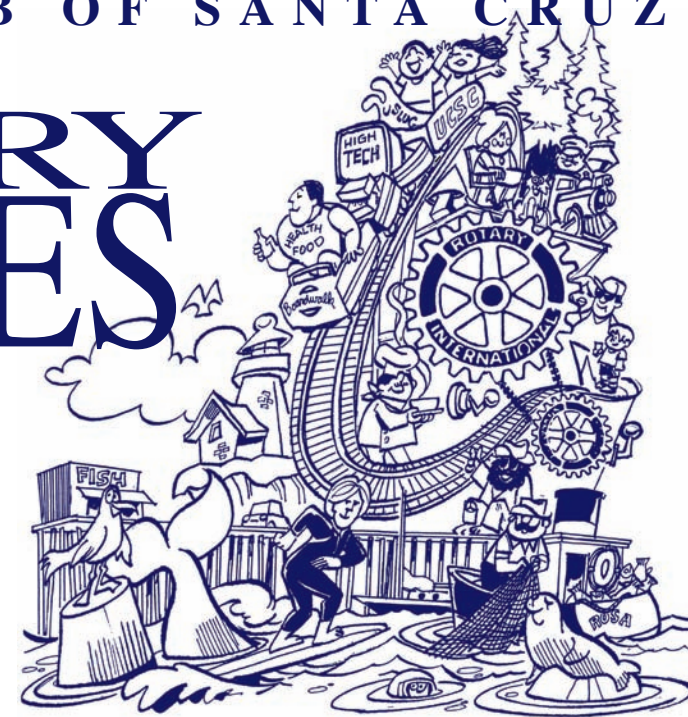

Tefertiller worked for the San Francisco Examiner from 1981 through 1995. His duties included beat coverage of both the Giants and A's, including the World Series teams in 1989 and 1990. It was his suggestion that the song "San Francisco" be sung at the resumption of the earthquake-delayed 1989 World Series. During his tenure at the Examiner he won two Hearst Awards for excellence in journalism.

Tefertiller's Wyatt Earp: The Life Behind the Legend, was published in 1997. It was the first and only major biography of the legendary lawman.
