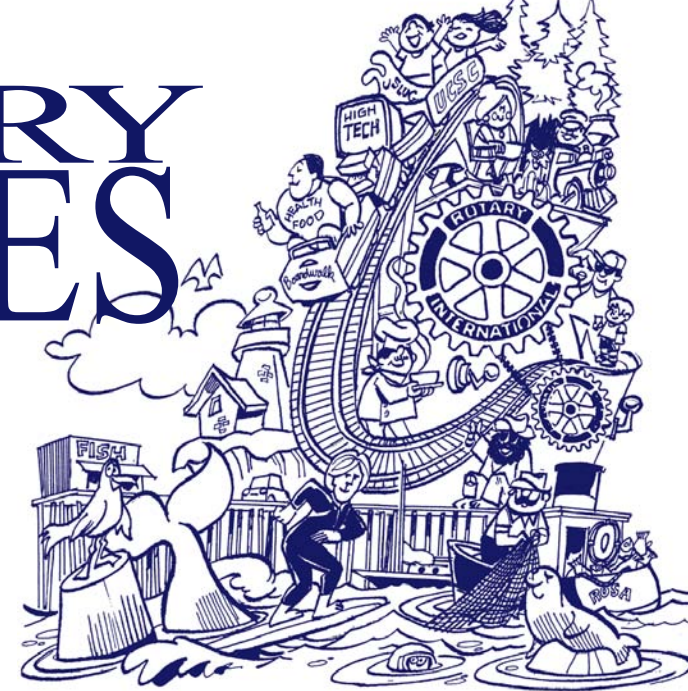

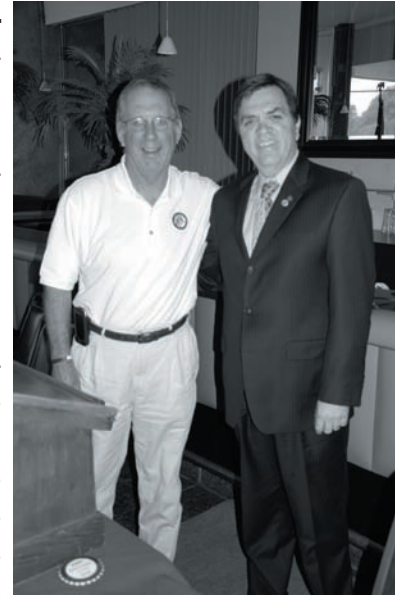

The Santa Cruz Lions participated in the purchase of a laser microscope; with Santa Cruz Rotary. **Steve Spragens** reported that Delta School had a successful year with a graduation class of 27. The school has 113 students. More than a 100% increase over the past three years. The Delta School thanked Rotary for the years of support. **Megan Mackenzie** will be the new president of Harbor High Interact. Megan



thanked the club for the financial support which will total \$1,000 for the year. **Ian Mackenzie** had a guest, Peter Koenen from Gilze, Holland. Mr. Koenen manufactures chocolate making equipment. Jim Williams was the day's detective. He

had fun with the members about those who color their hair; or lack thereof. He had a good time with both the men and women. The program featured **Ian McKenzie** and the Guatemala Rotary Eye Project. He showed pictures of the severe eye diseases that cannot be treated for the remote local indian peoples. Poverty and their remote location puts sophistic medical treatment out of reach. With a laser microscope, more advanced diseases can be treated quickly and with little chance for infection. The instrument was a refurbished model from Australia, with a price of \$13,500. Rotary donated \$4,000, the Lions \$4,001, and the balance was from the doctors who provide the treatment. The clinic has treated almost 5,000 cases since the facility began. The equipment is guarded by a nun who runs and lives near the clinic. She is very protective of her facility. It was a very fine program. Our thanks go to Keith and Della and all those who tend those Guatemalan people.
