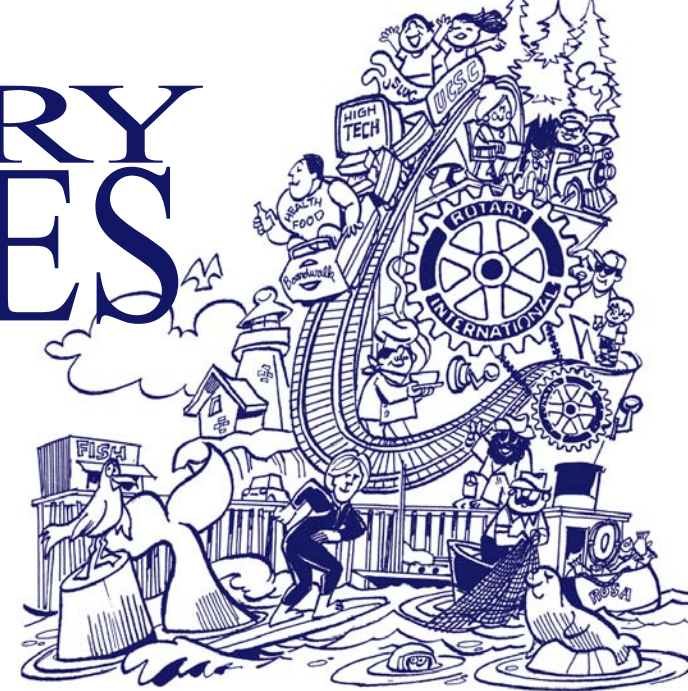

Program: Melissa Miller is a wildlife pathologist at the Marine Wildlife Veterinary Care and Research Center in Santa Cruz. Her goal is to examine every dead Sea otter found along the California coast to determine why it died. A forensic Veterinarian, Melisa is also called upon by law enforcement to investigate suspicious deaths of marine animals, often determining when these animals have met with human foul play.



Melissa is interested investigating the human contribution towards marine animal deaths identifying the parasites originating in cats, and transferred to sea otters via fish. Otherwise polluted rivers and streams also negatively affect the sea otters as well as other marine animals.

Interests include whale dietary habits, walks on the beach and looking for parasites in dead otters.
